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Meet 'Qasim the Nazim'

"Hum Aap Kay Khadim!"

Qasim is a councillor. A middle-aged family man with a wife, a daughter and a son. Qasim is an active and responsible member of his community. He is educated, empathetic and skilful. He is passionate and honest about his work, driven by the desire to improve the lives of his community, and by an overall pursuit of public good.

During his work as a councillor, Qasim faces challenges every day. Often uncertain at first on how to respond to these challenges, Qasim finds solutions with the help of supportive people, government officials and elected representatives from all levels of local government and the provincial level in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and Punjab and the resources around him. He does this while overcoming barriers and learning from mistakes. Qasim's efforts inspire not only other councillors but also people in his community: they look up to him and often learn from his example to find solutions in their own life and work.

Qasim: Telling Stories That Matter

Qasim is a fictional character created to help improve local government service delivery and increase citizen participation in decision-making in the provinces of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and Punjab.

Qasim's stories will help local government representatives – particularly councillors – build their knowledge and understanding of local government affairs and learn how best to handle their roles and responsibilities.

Qasim's stories will also encourage citizens – particularly poor and vulnerable groups, women, and youth – to take a more active role in their local government system, and to better trust and work more closely with their local representatives.

Qasim will reach his audiences through a range of media. His fictional character and stories will appear in printed material, animations, radio shows, and community performances (including puppetry and theatre).

Qasim was developed by Center for Communication Programs Pakistan (CCPP) and Deutsche Gesellschaft für Internationale Zusammenarbeit (GIZ) GmbH commissioned by the German Federal Ministry of Economic Cooperation and Development and the Swiss Agency for Development and Cooperation and will serve as a role model in the provinces of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and Punjab.
